## SYNOD EVENT COVENANT-YOUTH

This synod event is an intentional Christian community. In such a community, it is important that the behavior reflect the faith we share in Christ Jesus. This covenant is a promise that you make with the community to live within the standards established by the community.

- → I AGREE to be supportive. I agree to support others and treat them in a way consistent with
  the teachings of our Lord Jesus Christ. (I will not make fun of others, or make them feel
  inferior by my words or actions. I will strive to compliment the positive I see in others
  actions and behavior)
- I AGREE to participate. I agree to attend and participate in all community activities, including small and large group sessions and meetings. I further agree to encourage my peers and other youth and adults to do so as well. (I will not skip events to hang with friends or because I don't think it's important)
- ➡ I AGREE to stay on sight. I agree to remain on the property or site of the event for the entire event. In case of an emergency, and after advising my advisors and event staff of my whereabouts, I may go with permission.
- ➡ I AGREE to lights out. I agree as a youth, to remain in my own cabin after "lights-out" and
  to respect quiet time as designated by the event and the community to respect the needs of
  others to get rest. I will help enforce curfew and lights out by diligently ending my "Family
  Time" at an appropriate hour, and returning to and staying in my own room.
