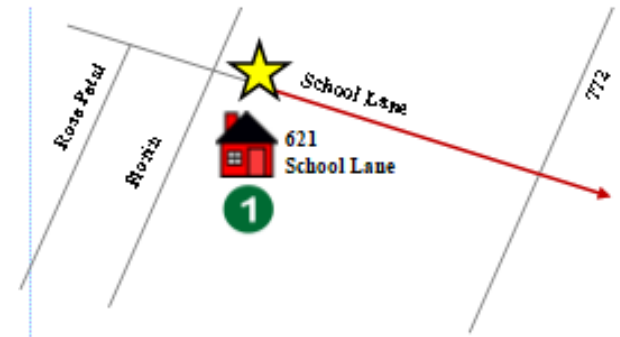
Look for these images as you journey towards the light!



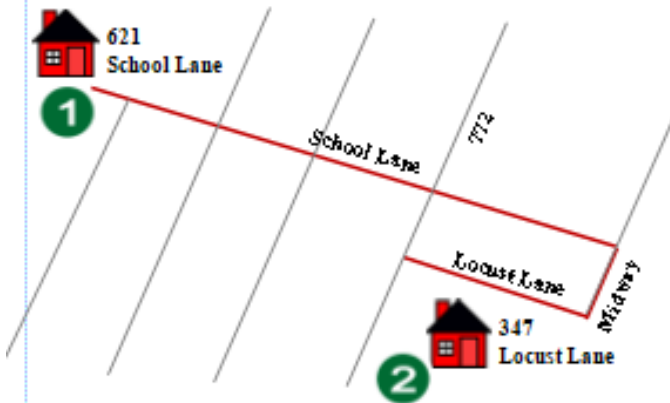
Follow the 7 trip-tiks left to right.

Our Journey Begins at 621 School Lane heading east towards route 772.



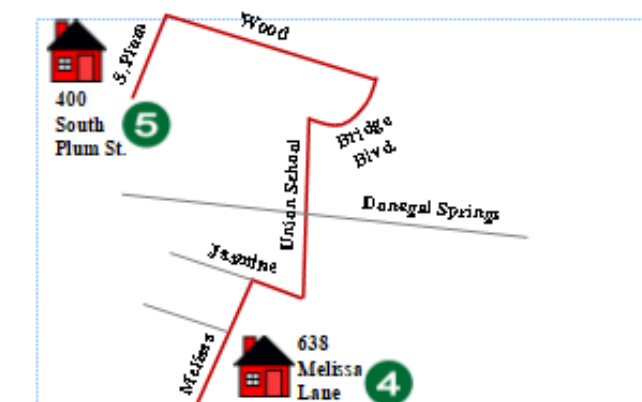
East on School Lane, Cross over 772, Right on Midway, Right on Locust



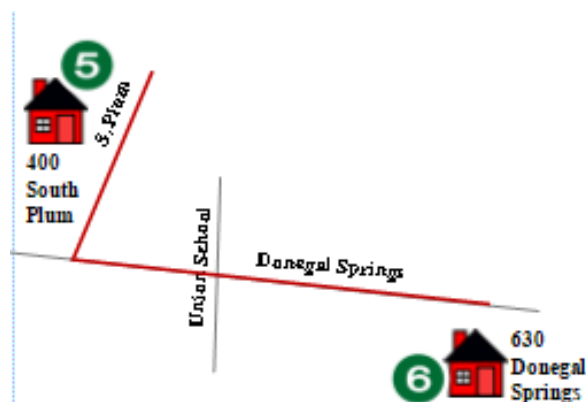
Left on 772, Right on Blossom Trail, Left on Arbor Rose

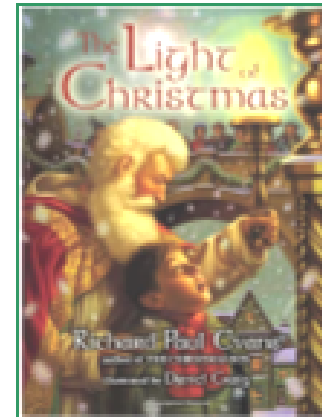
Left on Donegal Springs, Straight over Union School
